More good news to report this month! After more than a year of working closely with the LATCB, AEG Corporate, the Mayor's office, CTD Dept./Commission and our sales team to package an offer to attract a major piece of business for the LACC, we have landed Comic Con's sister show, WonderCon that will take place here next March 25-27, 2016. WonderCon was developed by the originators of Comic Con International back in 1987, which took place in Oakland for many years until moving to Anaheim four years ago.

Although WonderCon is not as large as the Mega Show- Comic Con International (which we are still pursuing for the LACC starting in 2017), it is a very large show, historically attracting more than 60,000 attendees. And many of these attendees and exhibitors are from out of town, to include some international travelers as well.

Booking Citywide conventions, tradeshows and special events is why the convention center was built many years ago as it attracts out-of-town visitors (attendees) that stay in our hotels, eat at our restaurants, shop in our stores, etc., thus creating economic impact (and jobs) for our great City. This booking is particularly beneficial to our City and economy as it is booked over the Easter weekend holiday, a typically hard time to sell space and historically our hotels have experienced very low occupancy during this holiday weekend. Bringing thousands of visitors to downtown Los Angeles during a holiday weekend that is typically very slow and empty is a very good thing!

Next year WonderCon attendees will be filling our hotels, restaurants, shops, etc. in addition to the convention center, generating an estimated \$32 million in economic impact over the three days of the show.

And just as importantly, Los Angeles will have the opportunity to showcase how many improvements have been made to the LA Live Campus and convention center, and how conducive it is to host events like this in Los Angeles.

It took the excellent teamwork between the LATCB, LACC, CTD, AEG Corporate and the Mayor's office to land this great piece of business, and it will take excellent teamwork to successfully host WonderCon next March. Something I know we can deliver.










We went dark for Earth Hour 3/28/15 #stopclimatechange
