Congratulations and thanks to all of you for making our first year of managing the Los Angeles Convention Center a great success. We hosted over 350 events, drawing in 2.5 million attendees in 2014. Although the City projected continued operational losses for our first year, we managed to end the year with a small financial surplus, which is virtually unheard of in the convention center industry.

Perhaps more importantly, we have improved the maintenance, cleanliness, operations and services of the Convention Center as a whole, which has resulted in an overall rating of 90% favorable through surveying of our licensees after each event. We're very proud of these enhancements and our efforts have made our client, the Los Angeles Department of Convention & Tourism Development, very happy.

Suffice it to say, we exceeded our goals and the City's expectations for our first year managing the LACC, and 2014 was a very successful year.

I'm confident that 2015 is going to be even better. We have more events booked and revenues should continue to grow as we improve operational efficiencies. We will also learn whether "Plan A"- the Farmers Field/LACC improvements project or "Plan B"-LACC Expansion and Modernization Project will move forward. Either option will drastically improve the LACC, and will result in a modern, upgraded facility, which will help us compete and continue to make the LACC and Los Angeles the destination of choice for conventions, meetings, corporate events and tradeshows. It's an exciting time to be a part of the Los Angeles Convention Center!
